



Right from the start you told us you wanted more places for children and young people to play safely. Last year we asked consultants to find out more, followed this year with designs based on your ideas. Children liked the field with space to run but wanted picnics, a 'play house', swings, climbing, slides and a zip ride. Young people favoured a gym, and adults wanted Tantony Green to be welcoming for everyone: Nice to see stuff that includes everybody"; "Some families can't afford

somewhere to spend the day, like this, is great." Now, in partnership with the Council, we're working on raising extra money to boost NMS's contribution so we can have a park to be proud of. Soon we could turn "boring" Tantony Green into a vibrant space for the whole community to enjoy – with a spinning disk, basket swings, towers with bridges, climbing ropes and slides, a zip wire, stone climbing stack, outdoor gym, picnic tables, wildflower meadow, 'butterfly sanctuary', herb garden and more!
