
Places for community empowerment

ABOUT NORTH MEETS SOUTH

North Meets South Big Local (NMS) is one of the 150 communities across England chosen to be part of the Local Trust's innovative programme that aims to achieve lasting change by providing a mixture of funding, finance and support. NMS was established in 2014 with £1 Million allocated from the Big Local Lottery Fund, through the Local Trust, that could be spent in any way local people chose over the following 10 years.

NMS is now a partnership governed by residents, with activities organised by residents and for residents in Marks Gate and North Chadwell Heath. As NMS Big Local enters the final stages of its funding support from the Local Trust, in January 2021, they published their 2021-2022 Local Plan. This Plan focuses on supporting sustainable projects which will exist beyond the lifespan of the organisation.
