### The main points

- We plan to build 257 top quality new homes for the Council.
- The Council will let them to local people on the housing list (this list includes 163 families from Marks Gate)
- Rents would start at £159 a week and more than a third are at rents equivalent to current council rents
- The new homes will be among our greenest - with solar panels and high insulation standards to reduce fuel bills
- The new homes will take up less than 20 per cent of the site

- We'll upgrade the remaining green space to create a linear park with a range of uses - from adventure play areas to orchards
- We'll upgrade the lake to increase biodiversity and accessibility
- There will be 124 parking spaces for residents including blue badge provision, plus car club spaces
- We'll use modern construction methods to speed up the building process and minimise inconvenience to existing residents
